VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT

The Kenya Film Classification Board (KFCB) is a State Corporation established under the Film and Stage Plays Act Cap 222 Laws of Kenya to regulate the creation, broadcast, distribution and exhibition of film and broadcast content to conform to national aspirations, values, culture and morality. Further, the Kenya Information and Communications Act (KICA) empowers KFCB to impose age restrictions on programmes to protect children and minors from exposure to harmful content.

The Board invites applications from suitable and qualified persons to fill the position below:

PART – TIME FILM EXAMINERS (6 POSTS)

Reporting to the Head Film Examination and Classification Department, the duties of a part – time examiner shall entail:

1. Examining, rating and approving film posters, trailers and commercials;
2. Rating of play stations;
3. Preparing reports on film examination and classification trends;
4. Undertaking any other duty that may be assigned by the head of department.

To qualify, the applicant must meet the following qualification requirements:

1. Bachelor's degree in any of the following fields: Sociology, Criminology Education, Law, Religion, film/ Video production or literature. An applicant with degree in another field and a diploma in any of the above fields will be considered;
2. Competency in computer applications.

NOTE: this is a purely part – time job and successful candidates will be assigned duties STRICTLY on need basis. The position does not attract any regular salary but an allowance will be paid on the basis of the movies examined and rated.

Interested applicants should submit their applications, enclosing day time telephone contacts, names and contacts of three referees and certified copies of National Identity Card and academic and professional certificates to reach the undersigned not later than **3rd February, 2017.**
